MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES

I once investigated a restaurant grease fire that resulted in several million dollars of damage to help our client determine who was at fault. The restaurant staff left the cooking line unattended and made the fire worse by pouring water on it once discovered. However, our investigation revealed that multiple parties were at fault for the loss: the fryer's safety controls had been removed by a previous contractor, the automatic fire suppression system was left inoperable after it was last serviced, and the ductwork – which was improperly installed – had about 80 pounds of grease inside.
