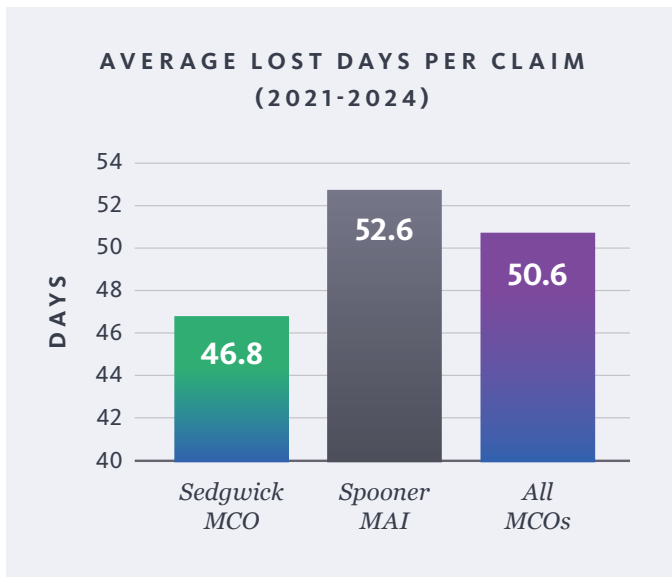


Sedgwick MCO and Spooner MAI performance comparison

Average lost days per claim

Accumulation of lost days is a key cost driver in claims, impacting premiums, savings options and workplace operations. A managed care organization that consistently facilitates a faster return to work for injured employees positions their clients for success. Sedgwick MCO outperformed Spooner MAI in average lost days per claim by **12.3%** in claims from 2021-2024.¹



FROI timing

First report of injury (FROI) timing measures the average days from the date of injury to submission of the claim to the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC). Injury reporting efficiency helps drive the treatment and return to work process and minimize lost workdays. Sedgwick MCO outperformed Spooner MAI in FROI timing by **9.8%**.²
